

This constitution and associated by-laws was last amended and approved at the business meeting of the 2010 ASCE Pacific Northwest Student Conference, hosted by Washington State University in Pullman, Washington. April 23, 2010.

We the members of the Pacific Northwest Region of Student Chapters of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), in order to foster desirable relations among the members of the Region, and to further the knowledge of the standards and ethics of the Engineering profession, do ordain and establish this Constitution and By-laws for the Pacific Northwest Region of Student Chapters of the American Society of Civil Engineers.

Article I

Charter members of the Region shall be the following student chapters:

Article II

Membership in the Region shall be open to all ASCE Student Chapters in the Pacific Northwest Region; however admission shall be subject to the approval of the Executive Committee.

Article III

An Executive Committee composed of two student delegates from each member Chapter shall meet during the annual ASCE Pacific Northwest Regional Student Conference. It is strongly recommended that the faculty advisor attend the executive committee meeting as a non voting participant. Each Chapter will have one vote on the executive committee. The purpose of this committee is to select the host Chapter for the succeeding conferences, and transacting any other business properly brought before it.

Article IV

The officers of the Chapter which is to be the host at the next conference shall automatically become the officers of the conference for that year.

Article V

This Constitution may be amended by three-quarter majority vote of the Executive Committee, in session, or by a three-quarter majority vote of the member Chapter by written correspondence. Any amendment must be presented in writing to all member Chapter not less than thirty days before it can be acted upon by the Executive Committee of member Chapter.

By-laws

First

The Regional Conference shall be held annually unless determined otherwise by a three-quarter vote of the member Chapter.

Second

These By-laws may be amended by a three-quarter majority vote of the Executive Committee in session, or by a three-quarter majority vote of the member Chapter by written correspondence. Any amendment must be presented in writing to all member Chapter not less than thirty days before it can be acted upon by the Executive Committee or by the member Chapter.
